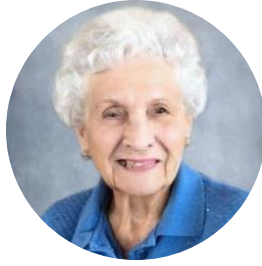

June Christine (Stopf) Cummings, age 92, of Seaford DE and Cambridge MD, passed away on April 25, 2017, at the University of Maryland Shore Regional Health Hospital in Cambridge, MD. She was born on December 30, 1924, in Poughkeepsie, NY, the youngest daughter of the late Ernest F. and Minnie (Hoffman) Stopf.

As a young girl, Mrs. Cummings traveled with her family from New York to Michigan, Pennsylvania, North Carolina, Florida, Alabama and Texas as they looked for work during the depression. She remembered picking blueberries and cotton in her travels. She married the love of her life, Samuel C. Cummings, Jr. on January 1, 1943, in Raleigh NC while he was in the service, and they were married for 62 years when he passed away on November 5, 2005. They made their home in Seaford, DE where they raised their family. Mrs. Cummings was a Den Mother with the Cub Scouts and she helped her husband with his business, S. C. Cummings & Son. In the 1970's she became the Manager of the Flagship Restaurant for about 10 years.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Cummings was preceded in death by her husband, Samuel C. Cummings, Jr.; her sons: Samuel C. Cummings, III in 1955, and Lawrence L Cummings in 1993; her brother, Ernest F Stopf, Jr.; her sisters: Anna L Wade, Virginia Uplinger, Victoria Clawson and Rose Milligan.

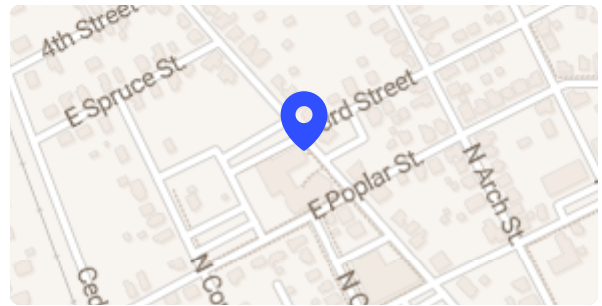

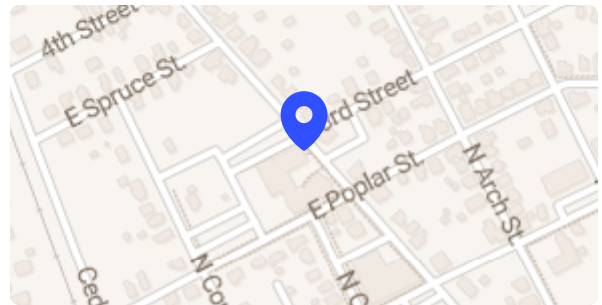

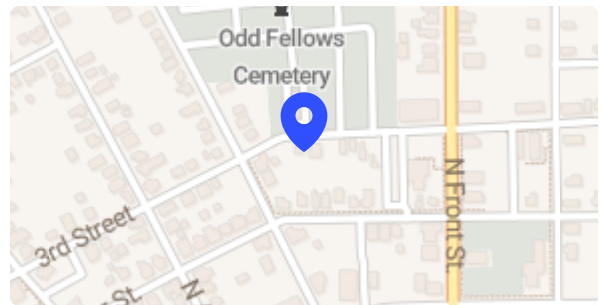
