Debra Ann Andell, age 55, of Milton, DE, passed away on Monday, November 26, 2018. She was born in Baltimore, MD, on July 28, 1963, daughter of Genevieve Ann Brittian and the late Charles Vance Brittian, Sr.

Debbie worked and lived in Sussex County for 38 years. During the late 80's Debra drove a boat for the Lewes Center for Physics (University of Delaware) later creating her own cleaning business to clean beach rentals. In the 90's she co-owned and managed Larry's Auto Repair in Lewes, DE. In more recent years Debra worked as a Letter Carrier for the United States Postal Service in Milton, DE for 13 years.
