Pauline McCabe Higgins died peacefully March 28, 2019, at Delaware Hospice Center in Milford with family by her side. She was 92.

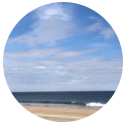

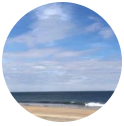
be remembered for her graciousness, gentle kind spirit, and love for life, which touched many lives.

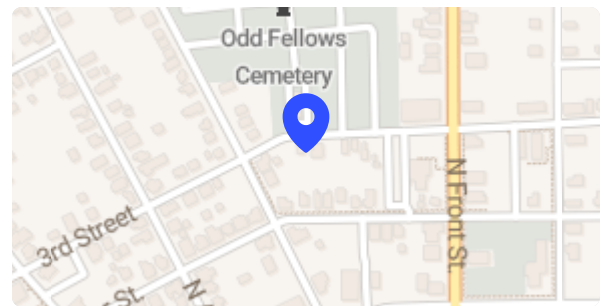
