Shirley Wick Snyder, age 88 of Lewes, DE, passed away on Wednesday, May 20, 2020 at Beebe Healthcare in Lewes. She was born on June 5, 1931 in Bryn Mawr, PA, daughter of the late Edwin Charles and Margaret Montgomery (Wagner) Wick.
