**M**ark “Jake” Ranson Jacobs, age 63, passed away at the Bayhealth Hospital, Kent Campus on Wednesday, February 23, 2022. He was born on January 4, 1959, in Dover, DE, the son of Samuel C.R. Jacobs and the late Kay Atchison (Jarman) Jacobs.

Mark was employed as a Housing and Community Development Supervisor for Kent County, DE, retiring after 30 years in 2018. Additionally, he also worked as a Mason for his father’s masonry company, Sam Jacobs & Sons, was a member of the Smyrna Clayton Jaycees and attended the Cheswold United Methodist Church. A graduate of Smyrna High School, he enjoyed all sports. He played baseball, football, and basketball, and was selected as best all-around male athlete in 1977. 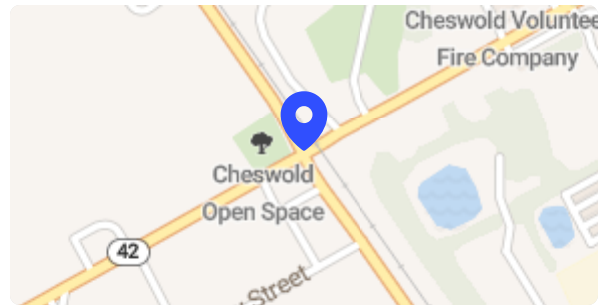

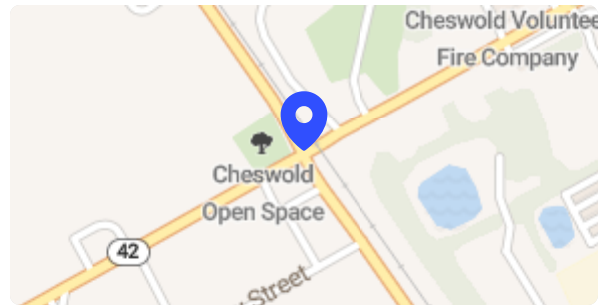
