Joseph “Joe Mac” Patrick McGuigan, age 57, of Seaford, DE, passed away suddenly on Sunday, November 13, 2022, at Tidalhealth Nanticoke Health Center in Seaford. He was born on June 5, 1965, in Norristown, PA, son of Frank Woodward and Joan (Dull) McGuigan.

Joe loved the open road and drove an eighteen-wheeler for AMH Bulk Transport for over fifteen years as their Lead Truck Driver. 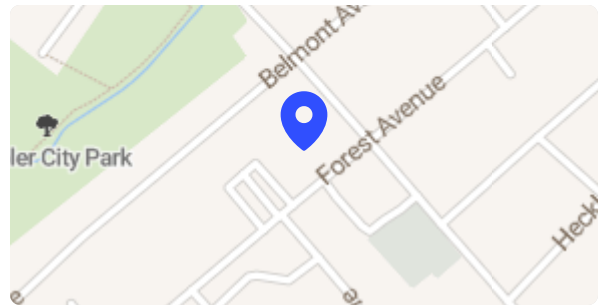

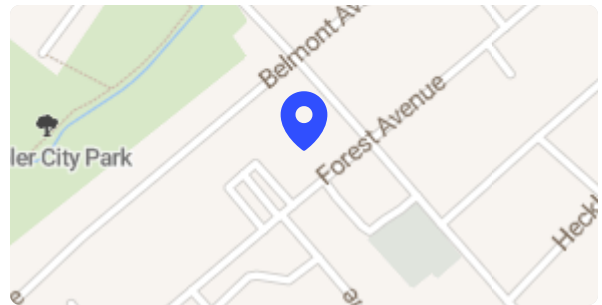
