**M**ilton Edward Foskey, age 91 of Seaford, DE passed away at home on Thursday, December 15, 2022. He was born on October 28, 1931, in Seaford, DE, son of the late Harry F. and Annie E. (Mitchell) Foskey.

Mr. Foskey was a proud veteran, having honorably served in the US Navy. During his service to country, he was a machinist on the Destroyer USS Carpenter.
