**M**ichael (Mike) Tully aged 82 of Seaford, DE, formally of Summerhill, PA passed away surrounded by friends and family at Christiana Hospital in Christiana, DE on April 20, 2023.

Mike was born June 9, 1940, in Johnstown, PA, the son of the late Bernard A. and Frances M. (Haberl) Tully.

He attended Adams Summerhill school where he enjoyed sports much more than he did his classes. Following graduation, he was proud to join the United States Army and served his country in Germany.
