Phyllis Lynn Wilson, age 84 of Seaford, DE passed away on Wednesday, August 16, 2023, at Lofland Park Center, in Seaford, DE. She was born March 3, 1939, in Seaford, DE, daughter of the late Benson Ira and Elizabeth (Newton) Allen.

Mrs. Wilson was a graduate of Seaford School District and had attended James Madison University where she enjoyed adventures in horseback riding and the usual college fun of the era. She was predeceased by her third husband, John (Steve) Dilks, who passed away from cancer in 2009.
