Kenneth Eugene Stamm Sr., age 84, of Seaford, DE passed away peacefully at TidalHealth Nanticoke Hospital on Tuesday, November 28, 2023. He was born on May 26, 1939, in Bethel, PA, son of late Earl I. Stamm and Elsie K. (Bordner) Stamm.

A man of many trades, Kenneth was endowed with a tinkerer's ambition and was always swift to solve the handyman problems. Matters of carpentry, electricity, and machinery were common pass time. Whether it was a large addition for the house, or a small shelf for his children, Kenneth's hands were always busy with crafting in the workshop.

An avid fisherman and outdoorsman, Kenneth embraced the elements. He camped with his family on a regular basis, and enjoyed fishing in the Delaware Bay, Indian River, and around the Chincoteague Island. Occasionally he hunted close to his mountain home in Bethel, PA.
