Albert Louis Johnson, age 69 of Seaford, DE, passed away on Saturday, February 5, 2022, with his family by his side at Mercy Medical Center, in Baltimore, MD. He was born on November 29, 1952, in Seaford, DE, son of the late George Earl and Rachel (Wheatley) Johnson.

Mr. Johnson built a lifelong career working as a welder for several companies, including Hanford Nuclear Plant, from 1978 until 1980; Palo Verde Nuclear Plant, from 1980 until 1985; Seaford Machine, from 1985 until 2000; and Saint John's Holding Company, where he worked for 9 years, retiring in 2010. He had many and varied interests and hobbies. He was skilled at repairing old tractors and welders and found great joy in watching his granddaughters race go-karts. Mr. Johnson was known as the tire washer, and he was a prominent fixture of North Oak Grove Road. He was a loving and devoted father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, and friend.
